## Overview

How best to live? \*Spoiler alert\*: the life of the mind -- so Aristotle claims in Book X of the *Nicomachean Ethics*. But this is only where the questions begin for us in this class, since we must ask how can we, as embodied beings, live the life of the mind? Man cannot live on contemplation alone, after all, so where exactly does Aristotle draw this line between the life of the body and the life of the mind? We will focus on the books that deal with this question (I, VI, X) and also read and discuss secondary scholarship to engage with a broad range of Aristotelian issues.
